- Travels to system laboratories to provide technical assistance with statewide audits and various quality assurance (QA) initiatives.
- Coordinates the development, validation and implementation of new methodologies and/or programs.
- Provides monitoring of technical QA programs within laboratory system.
- Assumes the duties of the Supervisor of Forensic Services in their absence.
- Performs any other reasonable assignments or duties as directed by the Supervisor of Forensic Services and/or Associate Director Drug Chemistry.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Shall have a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in the Natural or Physical Sciences.

AND

- Have a minimum of six years satisfactory experience performing the duties of a Forensic Scientist or its equivalent in another laboratory.

OR

- A Master's Degree in a Natural or Physical Science or Computer Science may be substituted for one year of the required experience.

Resumes will be evaluated to determine whether candidates will proceed to the interview phase of the process.

This position does not require that the candidate has taken and passed a NYS Civil Service examination, or currently holds a qualifying position within the NYS Civil Service System. This position will be filled through a resume review and interview process.
