The New York State Intelligence Center (NYSIC) serves as a central repository for numerous intelligence databases currently being used by the New York State Police and other local law enforcement agencies across the State. The NYSIC is a twenty-four hour, seven-day a week operation which may entail working all shifts with varying pass days, including HOLIDAYS and WEEKENDS. The goals of this facility are to provide for “one stop shopping” for criminal intelligence data that are currently stored in a multitude of automated files, improve, and strengthen the NYSIC’s intelligence program, and protect the state against future terrorist attacks.

The State Police Intelligence Analyst 2, SG-23 assigned to the New York State Police - New York State Intelligence Center (NYSIC) Counter Terrorism Center is the first supervisory level; performs analysis on more difficult casework utilizing standard established procedures. The Intelligence Analyst 2 focuses on terrorism-related investigative case support, lead development related to domestic violent extremism and homegrown violent extremism, social media review for terrorism threats to New York citizens and locations, and strategic data collection, analysis, and dissemination of terrorism-related intelligence via NYSIC products.

DUTIES:

- Performs all duties and functions of a State Police Intelligence Analyst 1.
- Develops investigative leads based on social media analyses, focusing on violent extremist activities.
- Examines sensitive law enforcement material submitted for support and analysis to extract appropriate data.

DUTIES (Continued):

- Analyzes data using systematic techniques to parse, locate, and extract case relevant data with value pursuant to investigative details.
- Testifies in court proceedings regarding casework involving routine methods of acquiring, archiving, and analyzing data.
- Uses established report writing standards to prepare comprehensive analysis reports used in criminal investigations or intelligence products, which may be entered into evidence during court proceedings.
- Answers the New York State Terrorism Tips Line as required, and provides appropriate investigative follow-up based on information provided.
- Trains and supervises State Police Intelligence Analysts 1 based on operational need.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's degree in the following or closely related fields of study: psychology, criminology/criminal justice, law, sociology, geography, geographic information systems, military studies, mathematics, telecommunications, chemistry, language, global studies, history, or intelligence studies, AND three (3) years of experience which must include critical data or intelligence analysis, including open-source intelligence research with preparation and presentation of intelligence reports and briefings for an organization in the military, private or public sector; conduct of homeland security, terrorism or counter terrorism analysis and assessments in a law enforcement, intelligence, or homeland security organization.

OR

- An Associate degree in the following or closely related fields of study: psychology, criminology/criminal justice, law, sociology, geography, geographic information systems, military studies, mathematics, telecommunications, chemistry, language, global studies, history, or intelligence studies, AND five (5) years of experience as described above.

OR

- Seven (7) years of experience in intelligence analysis for a governmental entity which must include critical data or intelligence analysis, including open-source intelligence research with preparation and presentation of intelligence reports and briefings for an organization in the military, private or public sector; conduct of homeland security, terrorism or counter terrorism analysis and assessments in a law enforcement, intelligence, or homeland security organization.

A Master's degree obtained in any field of study may substitute for one year of experience.

This position does not require that the candidate has taken and passed a NYS Civil Service examination, or currently holds a qualifying position within the NYS Civil Service System. This position will be filled through a resume review and interview process.
