Criminal Gun Clearinghouse Summary:

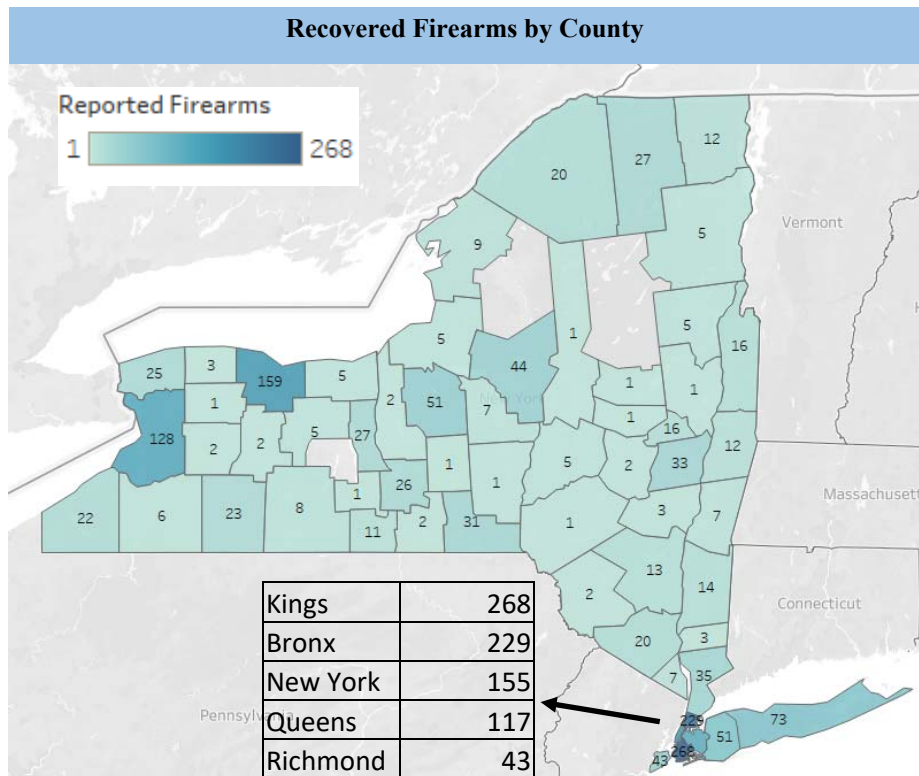
Whenever a gun comes into possession of law enforcement which was used, or believed to have been used, in the commission of a crime, certain firearm incident data is reported to the Criminal Gun Clearinghouse (CGCH) managed by the New York State Police. Between January 1, 2023 and March 31, 2022, a total of **1,321** firearms were submitted as crime guns to the Criminal Gun Clearinghouse.

Firearm Trace Data Summary:

All Criminal Gun Clearinghouse submissions initiate an ATF eTrace Report which provides the historical information on the firearm. Between January 1, 2023 and March 31, 2023, a total of **1,951** firearms were submitted to ATF for tracing. The statistics below were compiled using firearm trace data.
