



The New York State Police will host the annual "**Crimes Against Children Seminar**" during the week of **June 3-7, 2024 in Albany, NY**. This seminar is designed to assist field level personnel in the successful investigation of offenses committed against children. Field personnel who would benefit from this training include law enforcement, social service agencies, prosecutors, medical professionals, and victim advocates who work in New York State.

This extensive training is provided free of cost to attendees.

Topics to be presented include: A survivor's presentation; SANE nurse review; A child exploitation case review; 10 steps to consider in a Sex Assault Investigation; Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (ICAC); ICAC Investigations from the field; Children With Problematic Sexual Behavior; Child Abduction Investigations and more.

Each attendee must be registered individually and is expected to attend the entire seminar. Seating is limited and registrations will be processed in the order that they are received.
