

# NEW YORK STATE CRIME GUN REPORT

April 1, 2025—June 30, 2025



## Criminal Gun Clearinghouse Summary:

Whenever a gun comes into possession of law enforcement which was used, or believed to have been used, in the commission of a crime, certain firearm incident data is reported to the Criminal Gun Clearinghouse (CGCH) managed by the New York State Police. Between April 1, 2025 and June 30, 2025, a total of **1,322** firearms were submitted as crime guns to the Criminal Gun Clearinghouse.

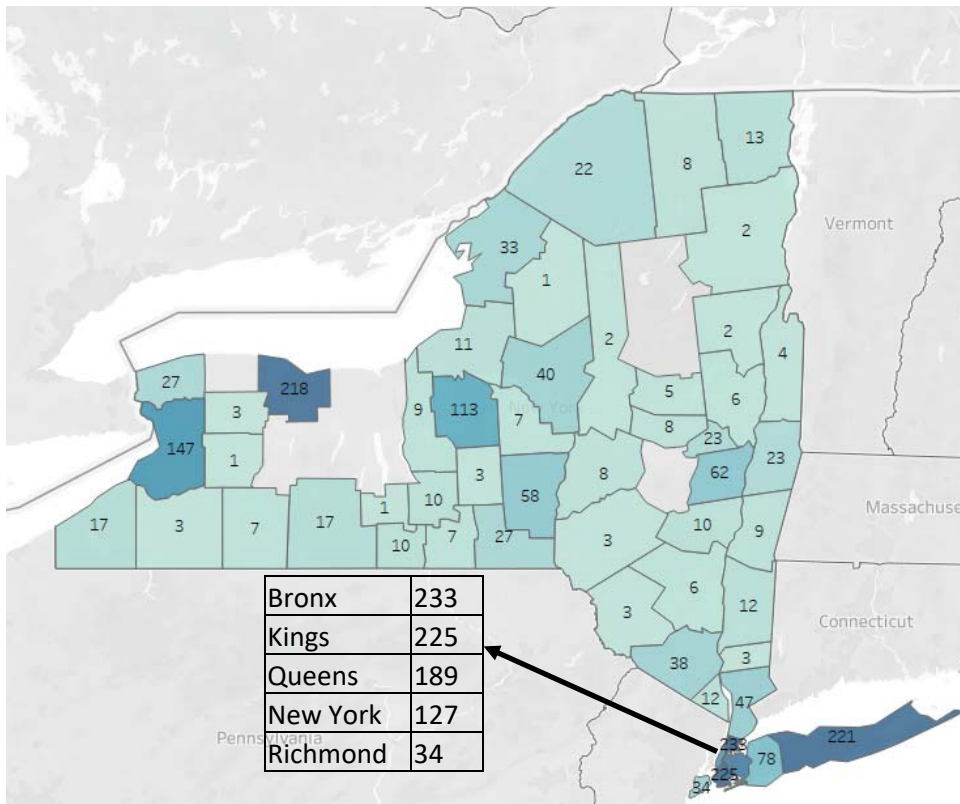

## Firearm Trace Data Summary:

All Criminal Gun Clearinghouse submissions initiate an ATF eTrace Report which provides the historical information on the firearm. Between April 1, 2025 and June 30, 2025, a total of **2,209** firearms were submitted to ATF for tracing. The statistics below used this trace data for compiling its results.
